

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS

In Term 4, 2024, families with a child enrolled in a government school from Prep to Year 12 in 2025 will receive the one-off \$400 School Saving Bonus.

The \$400 School Saving Bonus provides families with support for education-related costs, such as school activities and/or school uniforms and textbooks.

The School Saving Bonus is not available for full-fee international students, home schooled students, TAFE students and students attending kindergarten in 2025.

We need to ensure your contact information is up to date as the Department of Education will email you twice:

- -in October, to verify your email address
- -in November, with your \$400 School Saving Bonus and access to an online system.
- Please check your junk mail regularly to make sure you do not miss an important email.

REGIONAL ATHLETICS SUCCESS IN BENDIGO

Thursday 10th October our school's athletes took to the track and field at the Regional Athletics Carnival in Bendigo, marking another outstanding display of talent and determination. With an early start to the day, our athletes showed up ready to compete, and their efforts resulted in an impressive medal haul.

Key Highlights:

- Colby Marr claimed 2nd place in Discus, showcasing his strength and technique.
- Emilo Deluca had an incredible day on the track, taking home 2nd in the 100m sprint and powering through to 1st place in the 200m sprint.
- Aijay McDonald-Vozlic dominated the middle-distance events, taking 1st place in the 800m with a remarkable 40m lead, and also securing 1st place in the 1500m.
- Jack Burford ran a strong race, finishing 2nd in the 800m.
- In the field events, Georgia Kent leaped her way to 3rd place in long jump, while Brooklyn Hudak took 1st place in the same event.
- On the track, Eloise Kalms sprinted to 2nd place in the 200m.

The relay teams also put in impressive performances, with three of our girls' teams making the podium:


- 13 girls 4x100m relay: 3rd place (Layla Adams, Melanie Beswick, Tahli Kernaghan, Harper Scherger)

• 16 girls 4x100m relay: 3rd place (Chloe Carra, Charlotte Hawson, Georgia Kent, Lainesia Toutai)












STUDENT BROADBAND INITIATIVE

The Australian Government's <u>School Student Broadband Initiative</u> is offering a helping hand to 30,000 eligible families with school-aged students across the nation with access to a free NBN internet service. The initiative, designed to enhance educational opportunities and bridge the digital divide, is available to all Victorian families with school aged students.

Key Details:

- Application Deadline: Tuesday, 31 December 2024
- Free Services: Continues until 31 December 2025

Eligibility Criteria:

For families and carers to qualify, they must:

- Have an active enrolment at school
- Not have an active NBN internet service at home (excluding mobile internet services)
- Live in an area where NBN can be accessed through a standard connection (NBN Co will confirm this)
- Not have had an active nbn connection during the previous 14 days.






